See attached list of 90 names and addresses of residents in proposed district located on the northernmost part of Buena Park who are endorsing our district.

It makes sense because:

1. Each of the 4 districts fall within 0.57% deviation of the ideal of the population desideratum of 20,133 persons per district.
  2. In spite of the jagged shape of the southernmost part of Buena Park, the districts are fairly compact. Districts 1, 2, and 3 are reasonably compact whereas district 4 is more irregular due to the city boundaries.
  3. Regarding our community in district 1, we favor the proposed boundaries since it will keep our community intact.
  4. District 1 comprises of: the Bellehurst neighborhood, the Los Coyotes Country Club, the Smith-Murphy park, the Images park, Charles Emery school, Gordon Beatty school, the former Big Tee golf course and now Village Circle on Beach shopping center with the attendant increase traffic, the Mc Comber neighborhood, in addition to other neighborhoods, the Buena Park train station off Dale and Malvern, and the ever increasing traffic on Beach Blvd.
- Finally, a second version of districts 2, 3 and 4 is submitted as a contribution from the Buena Park residents.
