Dear Mayor and City Councilmembers,

I participated in the community forum/public hearing related to the creation and implementation of city council districts on Saturday, April 29, 2017. I communicated my concerns regarding the draft maps and process along with submitting three proposals for consideration, and I want to use this medium to contribute and submit one additional proposal with two options for consideration.

The fourth proposal achieves the following. The districts are compact and contiguous along with maintaining similar communities of interests within districts as much as practically possible. Significant geographical features (e.g. major roadways like Highway 78 and East Vista Way) for the most part are used to divide districts. The populations in each district are relatively balanced in both options (i.e. vary by 1% to 2% from the ideal population of a district) and the overall deviations are 3.02% and 4.20%.

There are slight differences between proposal options. In Proposal 4A, Population Block 49 is included in District A, and it achieves a majority Hispanic district in District A based on the "Total Population" and "Voting Age Population" statistics. In Proposal 4B, Population Block 49 is included in District D, and it achieves a majority Hispanic district in District A based on the "Total Population," "Voting Age Population," and "Citizen Voting Age Population" statistics.

I appreciate the Vista City Council taking the time to consider my proposals along with this feedback. If I can assist you further to accomplish the creation and implementation of city council districts, please feel free to contact me.

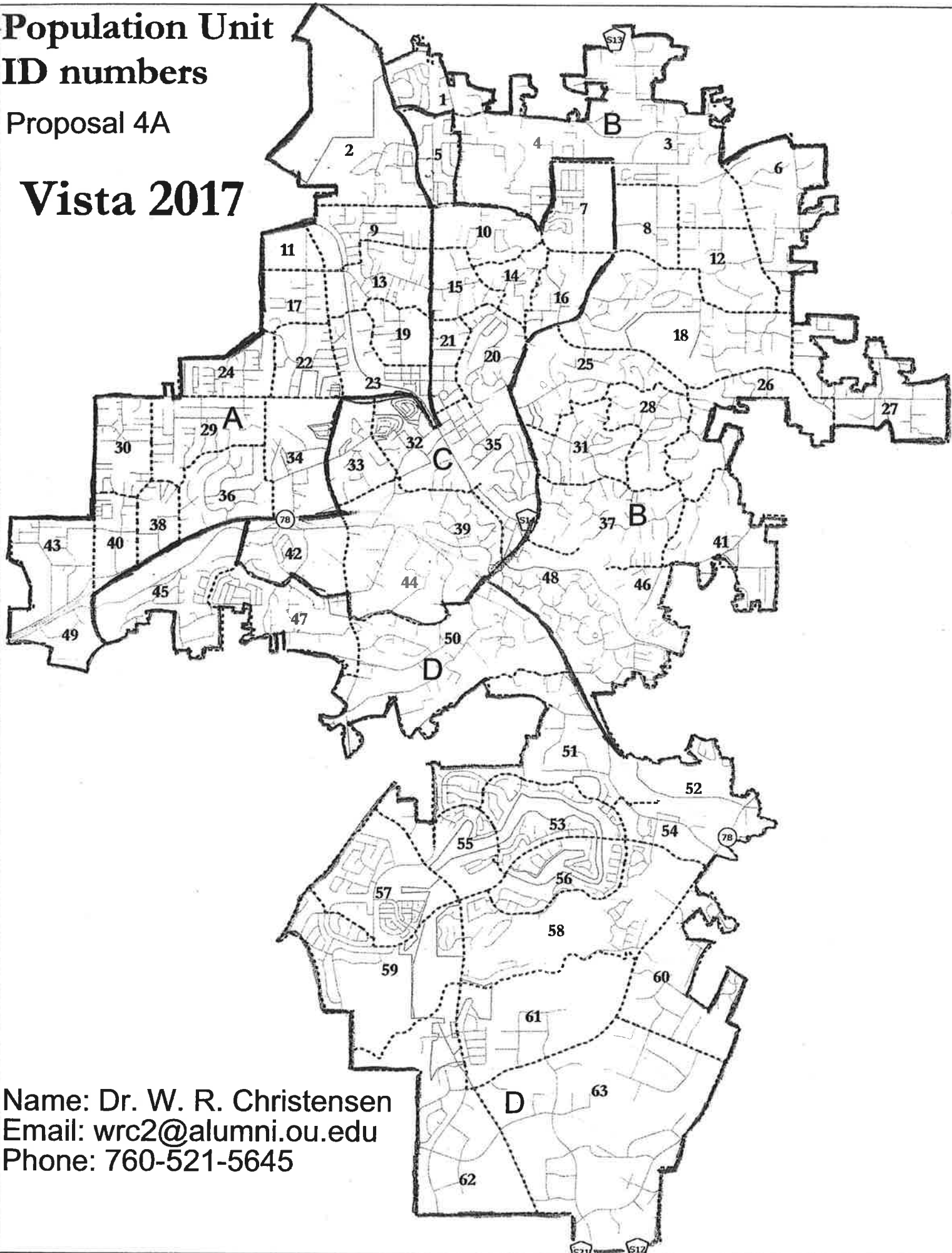

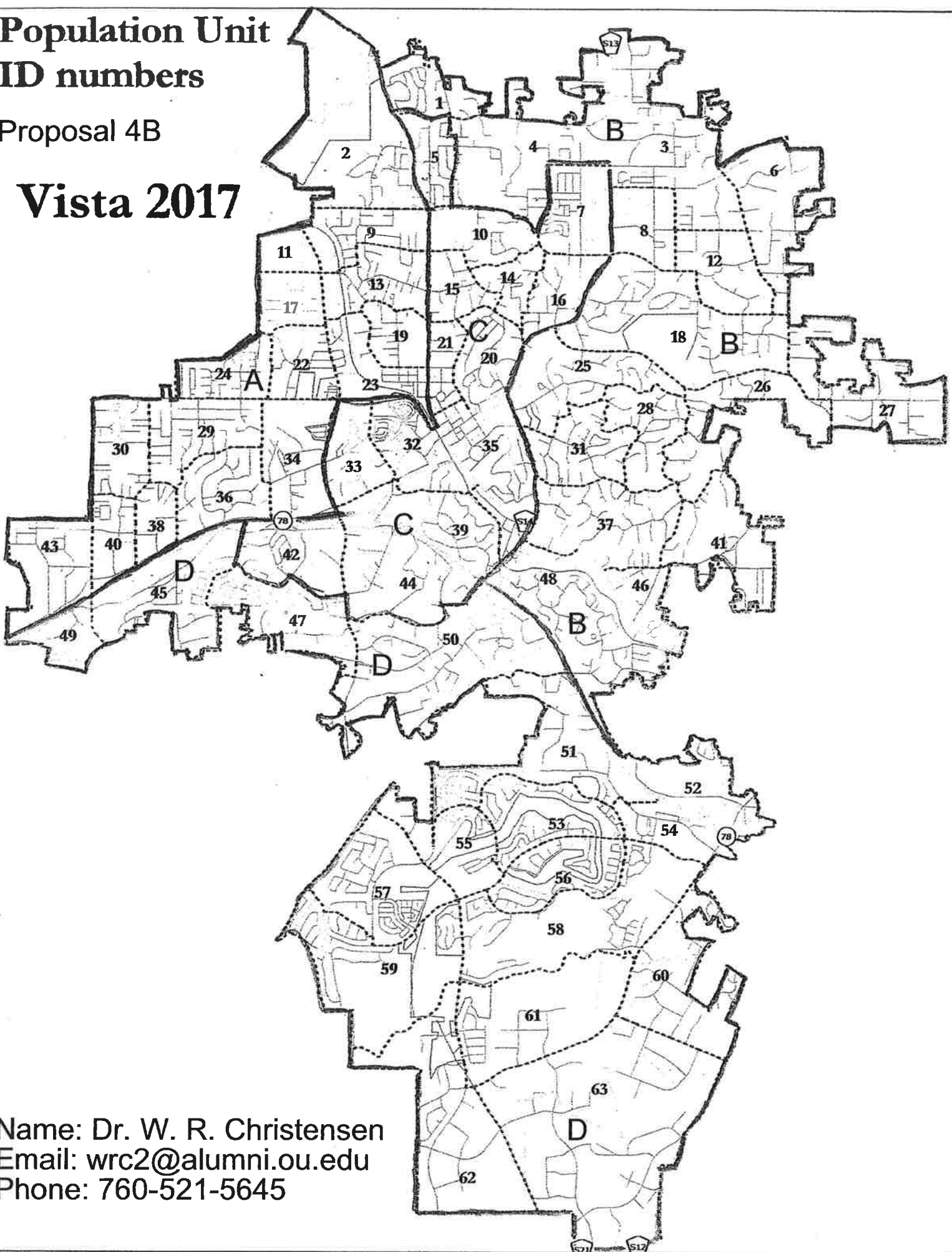
