Dear Mayor and City Councilmembers,

I participated in the community forum/public hearing related to the creation and implementation of city council districts on Saturday, April 29, 2017. I communicated my concerns regarding the draft maps and process along with submitting three proposals for consideration, and I want to use this medium to contribute and submit my last map proposal for consideration.

This proposal achieves the following. The districts are compact and contiguous along with maintaining similar communities of interests within districts as much as practically possible. Significant geographical features (e.g. major roadways like Highway 78 and East Vista Way) for the most part are used to divide districts. The populations in each district are relatively balanced (i.e. vary by 1% to 2% from the ideal population of a district) and the overall deviation is 3.39%.

I appreciate the Vista City Council taking the time to consider this proposal along with the previously submitted proposals. If I can assist you further to accomplish the creation and implementation of city council districts, please feel free to contact me.

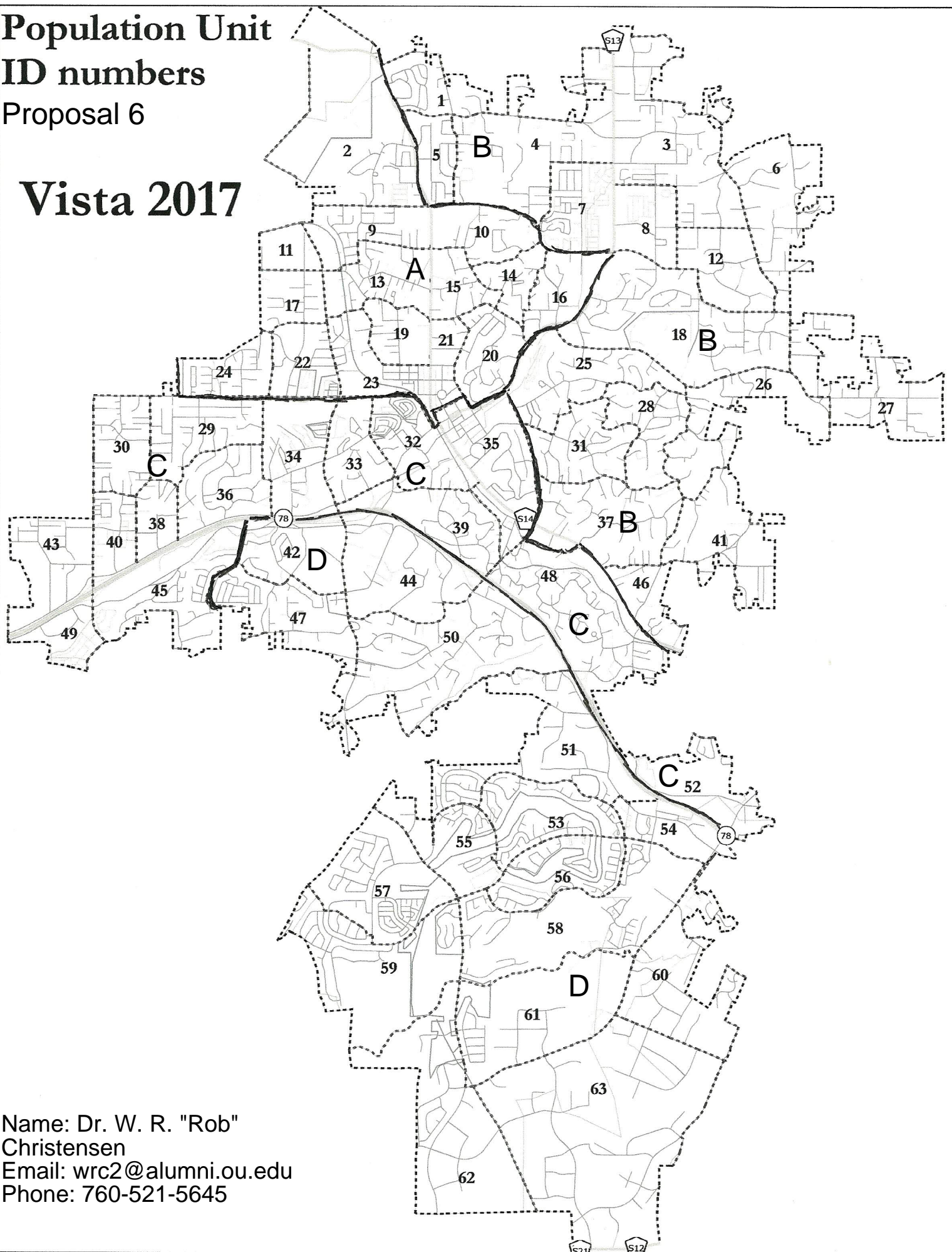
