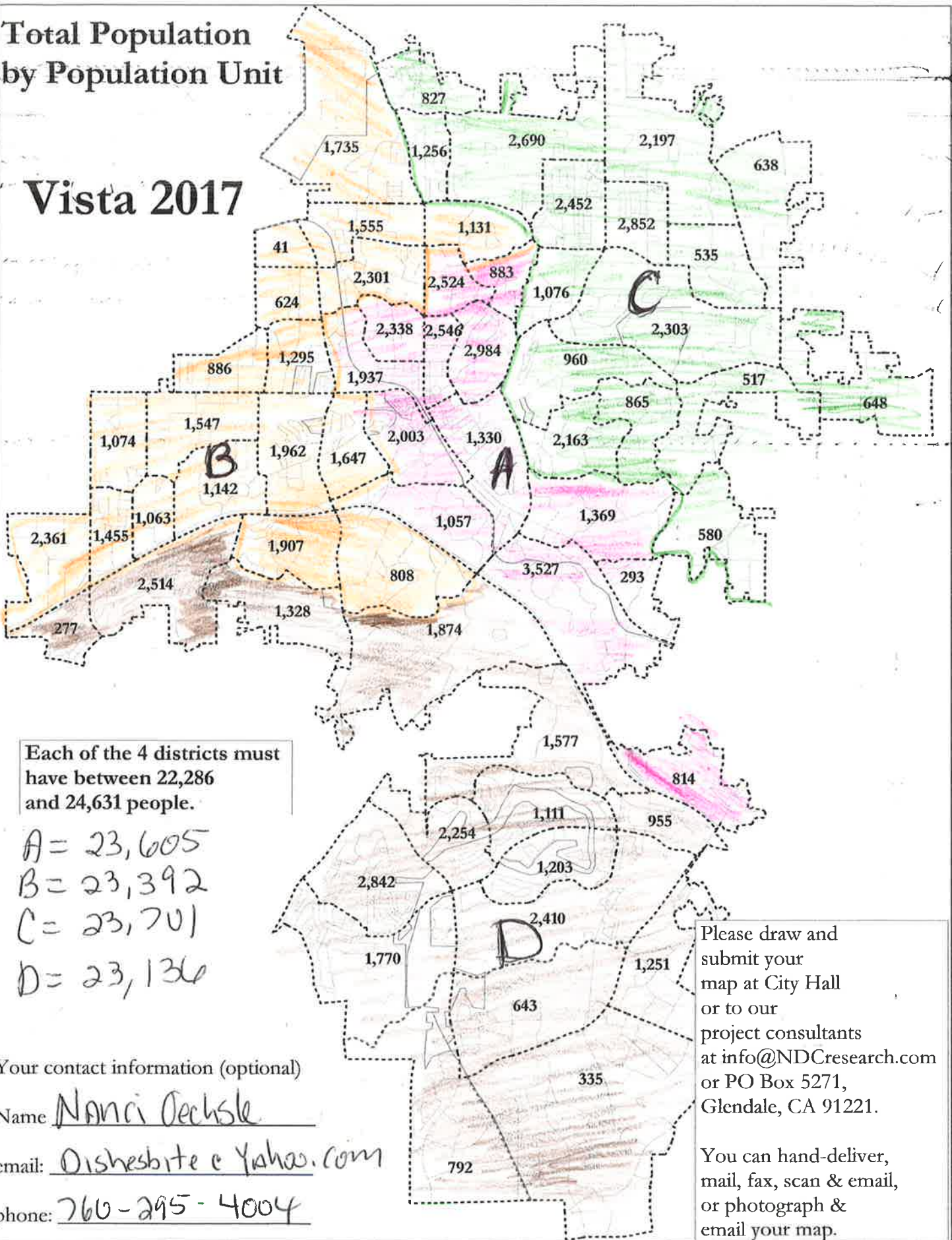

Vista 2016 Redistricting Criteria

1. Each Council District shall contain a nearly equal population as required by law; and
2. Council District borders shall be drawn in a manner that complies with the Federal Voting Rights Act and avoids racial gerrymandering; and
3. Council Districts shall consist of contiguous territory in as compact form as possible; and
4. Council Districts shall respect communities of interest as much as possible; and
5. Council District borders shall follow visible natural and man-made geographical and topographical features as much as possible; and
6. District borders shall be designed, insofar as this does not conflict with Federal or State law, to respect the wishes of the voters by avoiding the pairing of current Councilmembers.
