RESOLUTION TO ADOPT THE
EAST BAY REGIONAL PARK DISTRICT WARD BOUNDARIES

WHEREAS, the results of the 2020 Federal Census were released in 2021 and the East Bay Regional Park District is required to adjust its ward boundaries after each Federal decennial census so the wards, as far as practicable, contain populations of similar size; and

WHEREAS, the National Demographics Corporation (NDC) first presented to the Board of Directors at the September 7, 2021 Board Meeting

WHEREAS, NDC returned for the November 16, 2021 Board Meeting and January 18, 2022 Board Workshop where the Board of Directors and public received additional background information on the 2020 Census data and provided input on Communities of Interest; and

WHEREAS, the first public hearing took place on March 1, 2022 at which the Board of Directors reviewed two draft maps for consideration – Map A, the NDC Minimal Change map, and Map B, NDC Cities map; and

WHEREAS, as an outcome of this discussion the Board of Directors identified a preferred option for ward boundaries; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors held a second public hearing on March 15, 2022 at which the Board of Directors reviewed identified a preferred ward boundary map, which is attached to this Resolution and incorporated herein; and

WHEREAS, the preferred option for adjustment to ward boundaries minimizes changes to existing wards, keeps whole cities and communities in one ward to the extent possible, retains boundaries consistent with census tracts and blocks, aligns boundaries with other features such as county lines and city boundaries, achieves a population variance between wards of +/- 8%, and keeps current park representation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED the Board of Directors of the East Bay Regional Park District hereby adopts the new East Bay Regional Park District Ward Boundary Map, attached hereto as Attachment A.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Board of Directors of the East Bay Regional Park District hereby approves of the attached descriptions for District Wards 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6 and 7, and directs these be filed with the appropriate offices of elections in both Alameda and Contra Costa Counties prior to the 2022 election deadline.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the General Manager is hereby authorized and directed, on behalf of the District and in its name, to execute and deliver such documents, and to do such acts as may be deemed necessary or appropriate to accomplish the intentions of this resolution.
